
## Did you know...

## **City Centre Walk**

**Duration: 30 - 40 minutes** 

Distance: 1.5 miles Round trip: 3 miles

Start your walk from New Wortley Community Centre on Tong Road, head a few yards down to the end of Tong Road. Once there, cross over to Copley Hill under the bridge, passing by the Bike College.

Follow the road, passing Adam Court. When you reach the junction, take a left turn. You will be able to see the flyover bridge that awaits you. Cross over and keep on the straight path, passing by Dunelm Mill. If you need a pit stop, the café and toilets here can provide a brief respite.

Continue your walk by heading up Whitehall Road, continuing straight onto Aire Street. Enjoy the urban landscape as you make your way to the Leeds City Train Station.

Upon reaching the train station, take a stroll around to the front of the Queens Hotel. There, you'll find yourself facing City Square an iconic spot in Leeds. Take a moment to absorb the vibrant atmosphere, and perhaps plan your next stop in the city.

Leeds has so much to offer that you could spend days exploring and not see it all, so feel free to spend your time discovering its treasures. From cultural landmarks to hidden gems, there's something for everyone. If you've had your fill and it's time to head back, simply retrace your steps.

Alternatively, if the journey seems a bit much for the return trip, give yourself a pat on the back and consider taking a bus home. Walking both ways could be a goal for another day, but for now, relish in the accomplishment of a well enjoyed stroll through the heart of Leeds.
